Title: New York Right of Publicity Law: Reimagining Privacy and the First Amendment in the Digital Age

Description: The New York State Assembly is currently considering Assembly Bill A08155, which would expand New York's right of publicity by making it a property right that can be passed onto a namesake's heirs. Critics of the Bill say it will chill speech by limiting the use of a namesake's name or likeness even after their death. We will be inviting practitioners and academics to the event to discuss the pros, cons, and potential alterations to the Bill.

Since 1987, Cardozo and BMI have come together to host this exciting competition.

As a bailiff, you will be responsible for escorting the judges to each round, keeping time, and handing off official score sheets to a designated runner. As you escort the judges into the room, you will announce them to the "court." During the round, another volunteer will time the rounds, and at designated marks (i.e. 10 mins, 5 mins, 3 mins, 1 mins) you will hold up time cards for competitors and judges. For this position, you will need to dress as if you are going to court (business attire).

If you have any interest in trying out for the Moot Court Honor Society, this is a really great opportunity to watch a real moot court competition and interact with Society members (participating as a bailiff in no way guarantees membership.) However, we encourage everyone (regardless of MCHS interest) to get involved with this exciting event and act as an ambassador for our school.
