Is the Internet **Over**?! (Again?)

In his talk, Prof. Boyle explores and evaluates predictions about the Internet from the 1990s, and where cyberspace is heading in the next 20 years.

James Boyle is the William Neal Reynolds Professor of Law at Duke Law School and founder of the Center for the Study of the Public Domain. His most recent books are *Theft: A History of Music*, a graphic novel about musical borrowing through history, and *Intellectual Property: Law and the Information Society*, both co-authored with Jennifer Jenkins. Professor Boyle was one of the founding Board Members of Creative Commons and of Science Commons and served on the board of the Public Library of Science. His work on digital civil liberties was honored with a Pioneer Award by The Electronic Frontier Foundation.
