Please join us for a lunch talk with Robert Toomey, Managing Director and Associate General Counsel of the Securities Industry and Financial Markets Association (SIFMA)! Mr. Toomey will describe the way that the 2008 financial crisis completely changed the compliance landscape for financial services firms. He will also discuss the challenges of implementing changes required by the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act, the financial reform legislation passed as a response to the financial crisis.

At SIFMA, Mr. Toomey is responsible for staffing SIFMA's Rates Area (encompassing U.S. Federal government and agency debt businesses and short-term funding businesses, including repo, securities lending, prime brokerage, and money market instruments). He is also the principal staff person at SIFMA coordinating advocacy on the Volcker Rule. Prior to joining SIFMA's predecessor, the Bond Market Association, Mr. Toomey served as Counsel at the Federal Reserve Bank of New York, and as Special Counsel at the Securities Exchange Commission in the Division of Corporation Finance. Prior to his time at the SEC, he was an associate at the law firm Reid & Priest.
