FLOERSHEIMER CENTER AND CDLI HOST TECH TALK ON INTERNATIONAL CYBER LAWS



March 8, 2019

Duncan B. Hollis, Professor of Law at Temple Law School, talked election hacking, fake news and setting global cybersecurity standards at “The Emergence of Global Cybernorms” event on Thursday.

Floersheimer Center for Constitutional Democracy Co-Director and Cardozo Professor Deborah Pearlstein led the discussion. The event was also sponsored by the Cardozo Data Law Society.

Hollis mentioned many of the threats present in today’s cybersphere, including the increasing absence of humans in technology.

“Machines can write their own malware,” Hollis said. “Errors are inevitable.”

The talk centered on the Paris Call for Trust and Security, which aims to set international standards for cybersecurity.
