"There's a high standard for imposing a conservatorship, in theory...what we find in practice is that it's imposed too readily when less restrictive alternatives might suffice," says Diller.

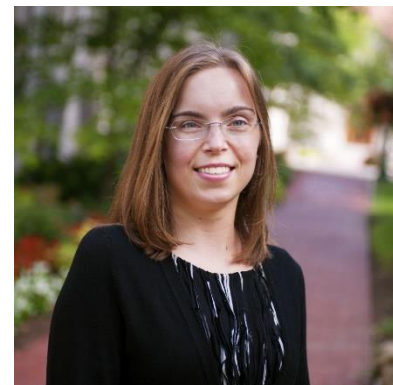
