Professor Andrea Kupfer Schneider Speaks to Reuters on UAW Strike Not Expanding Against Ford

“In sort of the divide and conquer, or at least in demonstrating that there are rewards to Ford, and thereby signaling to others that when some of the demands are met, it's not that the strike against Ford is ending, but that at least it will not expand,” Schneider said. “And so it also allows the union the flexibility to really ratchet up the strike, or ratchet down the strike in very nuanced ways.”
