Marc Lasry is the Chairman, CEO, and Co-Founder of Avenue Capital Group, a global alternative investment manager focused on distressed and undervalued debt and equity opportunities in the U.S., Europe and Asia with 11 offices across the globe. In 1995, Mr. Lasry formed Avenue with his sister Sonia Gardner '86, with less than \$10 million in capital from friends and family. Today, Avenue is one of the largest distressed debt investors globally, managing over \$10 billion of assets. Mr. Lasry is known as a pioneer in distressed investing which has been the focus of his professional career for over 33 years.
