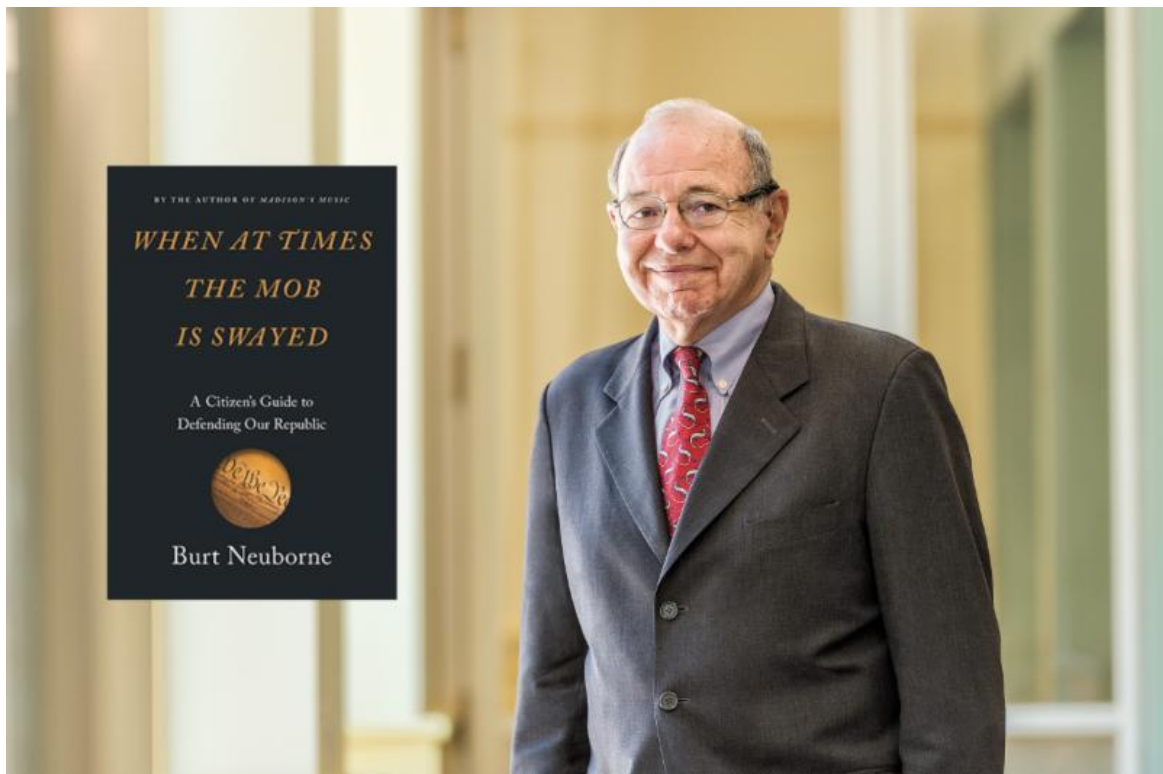

Professor Burt Neuborne (NYU Law) is one of the nation's foremost civil liberties lawyers and scholars. Over the years, he has challenged the constitutionality of the Vietnam War, worked on the Pentagon Papers case, partnered with Justice Ginsburg on women's rights, and served as the ACLU's national legal director during the 1980s and as founding legal director of the Brennan Center for Justice at NYU School of Law from 1996-2007.

His latest book, [When at Times the Mob Is Swayed: A Citizen's Guide to Defending Our Republic](#) (The New Press, [link](#)), assesses the capacity of our "institutional brakes" to resist current pressures to alter important aspects of our constitutional democracy.
