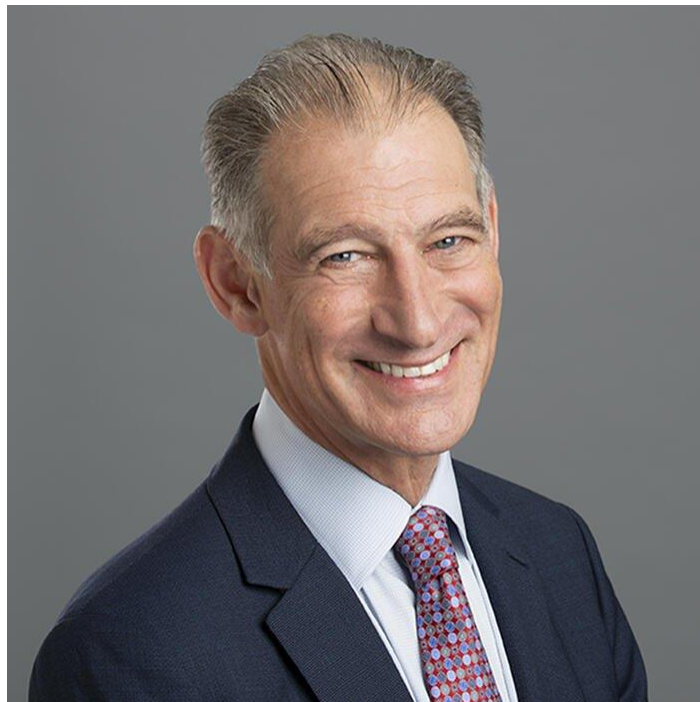

This week, the Supreme Court decided *Seila Law LLC v. Consumer Financial Protection Bureau*, a major separation-of-powers case regarding the structure of the CFPB. The Bureau is unusual, though not unique, in being headed by a single person who can be fired only for cause. By a 5-4 vote, the Court held that this arrangement

unconstitutionally restricted the President's executive authority. However, the justices "severed" the offending provision, declining to eliminate the agency altogether.

In today's live ***Unboxing the Law***, Cardozo professor Michael Herz, a former clerk for Associate Justice Byron R. White, will break down the case, explain the legal theory behind it, and discuss what the decision means for the future.
