## Professor Jessica Roth Appeared on ABC News and was Quoted in USA Today and Bloomberg about the Ghislaine Maxwell Arrest



Professor Jessica Roth was featured in numerous media outlets, including an appearance on **ABC News**, discussing Ghislaine Maxwell's arrest.

Additionally, Professor Jessica Roth was quoted in **USA Today** saying the charges against Ghislaine Maxwell "reflect the other shoe dropping" in the case against Epstein. "The indictment against Epstein made clear that he did not act alone and was assisted significantly by others in his sex trafficking crimes," Roth said.

She also was quoted in **Bloomberg**. "There is no way for prosecutors to present a case against her without going into all the evidence they had against Epstein,

because the charges here are intertwined,” said Professor Jessica Roth. “The original indictment against Jeffrey Epstein made it clear that he didn’t act alone and that the government had evidence that other people were also involved.”

In an additional **Bloomberg** article, Professor Roth stated, considering Maxwell's arrest, “The fact that she remained in the United States and was found in the United States is certainly a factor I think pointing in her favor that the defense will stress.”
