Bioethics studies the intersection of law, medicine and ethics. The Einstein Cardozo Program in Bioethics is one of a few Master programs in Bioethics firmly based in both a medical school and a law school, and the only program in NY where students can graduate with a JD/MBE in 3 years. Cardozo students can enroll in the Master Program and obtain a Master of Science Degree in Bioethics (M.B.E) by taking limited additional coursework and paying a tuition supplement. Students can also obtain a Certificate in Bioethics and Medical Humanities or simply take one or more of the various interesting bioethics courses, many of which count towards a Cardozo J.D.

This informational session will be hosted by Professor Ed Stein, who is the Cardozo Director of the Einstein Cardozo Bioethics Program and the Director of the Gertrud Mainzer Program in Family Law, Policy and Bioethics. Prof. Stein will be joined by Dr. Tia Powell, Professor Lauren Flicker, and JD/MBE graduate Elana Begualid Harary L'19. Dr. Powell is Director of the Bioethics program, holds the Dr. Shoshanah Trachtenberg Frackman Chair in Bioethics at the Albert Einstein College of Medicine and is the Director of the Montefiore Einstein Center for Bioethics. This fall, Dr. Powell will be teaching Bioethics for Pandemics. Professor Lauren Flicker, who is Associate Director of the Bioethics Program and of the Montefiore Einstein Center for Bioethics will be teaching The Legislature in the Clinic. Both Dr. Powell and Prof. Flicker are part of the joint faculty for the year-long course Bioethics and the Medical Humanities, that serves as the introductory course for the MBE and constitutes the Certificate Program in Bioethics. All three courses will be taught online at Cardozo this fall.
