In his role as CBRE's Chairman of Global Brokerage, Stephen Siegel advises major corporations and property owners on a broad range of real estate strategies. He is widely regarded in commercial real estate circles as one of the industry's most talented and prolific professionals, and has been called by the media "a powerhouse," "an icon," "a game changer" and "the most legendary and revered broker still plying the trade in NY." Prior to the merger with CBRE, as Chairman and CEO of Insignia/ESG, Mr.

Siegel was largely responsible for masterminding the expansion of the firm nationwide as well as throughout Europe, Japan, Hong Kong, China, Thailand and Latin America. In that role, he also managed a group that completed approximately \$2 billion in co-investments in a wide range of U.S. office, residential, hotel and retail real estate portfolios. Mr. Siegel initially rose to prominence in the industry at Cushman & Wakefield, where he became President and CEO at age 37.
