Associate Dean Val Myteberi Speaks to LLM Guide about Law School Innovation During the Pandemic



Associate Dean for Graduate, International & Online Programs **Val Myteberi** was quoted in *LLM Guide*, on how law schools are revamping their LL.M. programs in response to the pandemic.

Cardozo is launching a new online LL.M. in Intellectual Property and Myteberi said, "Intellectual property law has transformed into a highly complex and globally important field, playing a major role in the socio-economic wellbeing of countries around the world."

She continued, "Prior to Covid-19, it was unimaginable that lawyers in New York could work fully remotely for months without some damage to their firms. But lawyers are resilient, and technology has made it possible to serve clients with care and efficiency from anywhere in the world. I remain optimistic that the pandemic

has taught us all a lesson about the importance of having a healthy balance between our well-being as humans and our career goals as professionals," she said. "I hope that this pandemic brings about long-term changes to the delivery of legal services, so that lawyers can benefit from a meaningful work/life balance."
