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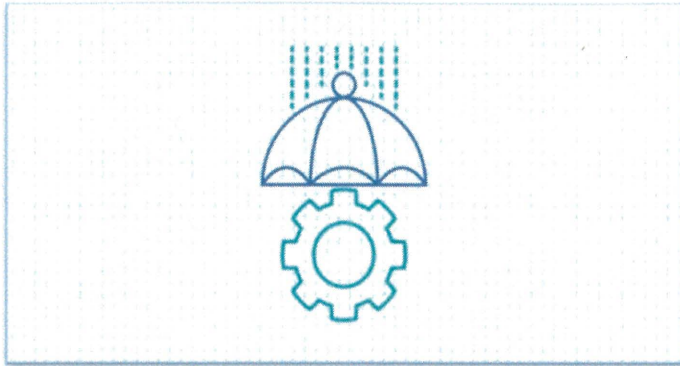

- PWC estimates that blockchain can deliver \$5-10 billion in savings on reinsurance
